

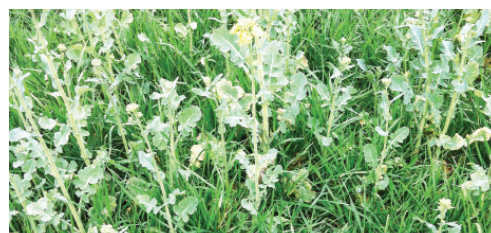
Residual herbicide for common weed control

- Residual herbicide for the control of a range of common weeds including black-grass, in Winter Oilseed Rape and Winter Beans
- SOLITAIRE is an invaluable tool in the control of black-grass with no resistance recorded to date to propyzamide

Resistance

Strains of some annual grasses (e.g. Black-grass, Wild oats, and Italian Rye-grass) have developed resistance to herbicides, which may lead to poor control. A strategy for preventing and managing such resistance should be adopted. Guidelines have been produced by the Weed Resistance Action Group and copies are available from the HGCA, CPA your distributor, crop adviser or product manufacturer.

How to stop propyzamide reaching water - The Voluntary Initiative

Unless extreme care is taken to prevent propyzamide from leaching into water courses there is a serious risk that the use of this valuable active substance could be restricted.

All pathways matter. Follow basic water protection advice:-

- Take care when filling and cleaning the sprayer
- Use a 6m grass buffer strip, or a 5m no-spray zone, beside water courses
- Discuss cultivation and spray timing with your BASIS registered adviser
- Manage soils and tramlines to avoid surface run-off or erosion
- Do not apply when soils are cracked, dry or saturated
- Do not apply propyzamide if heavy rainfall is expected within 48 hours of application
